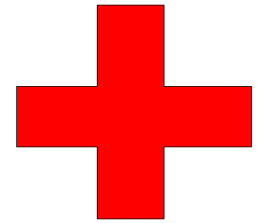

Disaster Action Team Member (DAT)

Join the American Red Cross providing critical relief services when disaster strikes right here in your community or around the nation. The Red Cross provides on-scene essential aid and comfort to victims of residential fires and responds to local and national disasters. Team members sign up and train for any of several responsibilities: sheltering, feeding, supply distribution, client casework and other vital tasks. We will teach you the important skills necessary to get your family prepared for disaster and for you to respond to small and large disaster events.

Preparedness & Response Instructor

Serve your community by teaching others to save a life. The American Red Cross is seeking volunteer instructors for first aid; infant, child, and adult CPR/AED; baby-sitting and other lifesaving courses. Instructors are needed throughout the year for classes that will be offered days, evenings, and weekends. Free training will be provided to volunteers with a commitment to teach. No prior experience necessary.
